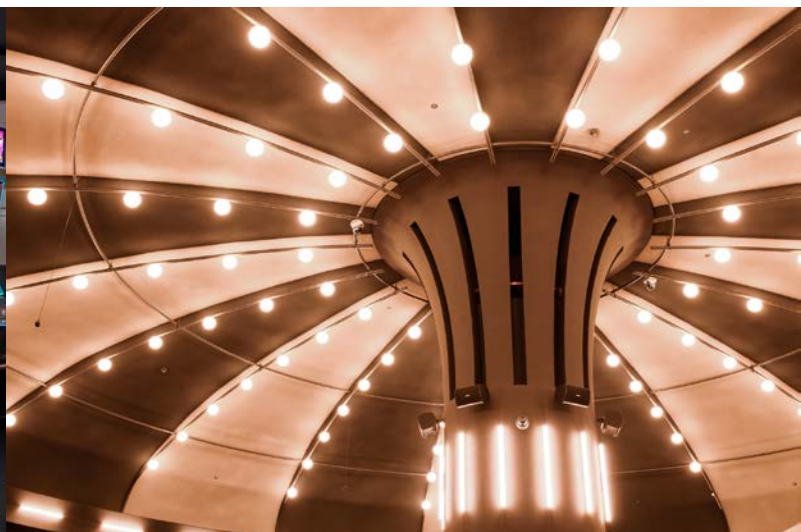
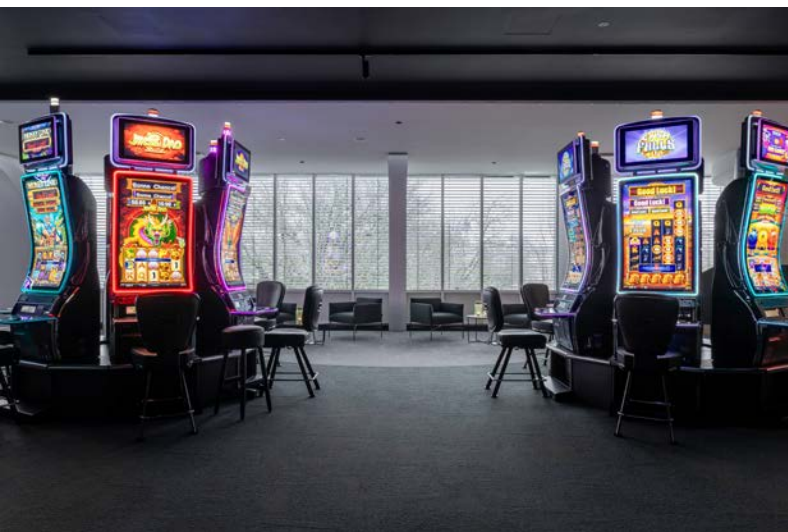

TABLE GAMES

The casino's gaming room opened in 2022. Modern, warm and intimate, it offers carpet enthusiasts the chance to play roulette or Black Jack 'the old-fashioned way'.

In a confidential, subdued atmosphere, an English roulette table and a Black Jack table will be open on Mondays, Thursdays and Sundays. And even two Black Jack tables on Fridays and Saturdays!

After ordering a drink at Cooper's, you can take the brass staircase up to the control room of this premium venue. Proper attire is required and the minimum bet is 10€. The chic, intimate room welcomes customers behind smoked glass with metal mesh inserts, so you can guess what's going on inside without actually seeing.

As you enter the room, armchairs and sofas invite you to take your time. Make yourself comfortable enjoy your signature cocktail before joining a game. For the more impatient, a high table in the middle of the gaming area allows players to wait their turn while still being at the heart of the action, with a view of the gaming tables and the games in progress.

With such a floral name, it was Monet and his gardens at Giverny that inspired the Parisian-Luxembourg architectural firm of Elodie Lenoir, which was responsible for the new look of Restaurant Les Roses.

The magnificent round dining room, with its immense, luminous bay window, has been completely revamped to look like a winter garden. In keeping with the spirit of the times, of course, the new space is soft and cosy, with an emphasis on natural materials. Like an Impressionist painting.

Dark wood covers the walls, the oak tops of the round and oval tables are inlaid with marble, forest green velvet adorns the benches, stone the central panels and golden touches of hammered brass the hanging lights dot the sky. In the centre, curved partitions create a privileged modular area. This central space is topped by a mirror-effect ceiling, providing light, elegance and privacy.

François Jagut has taken over the kitchen with a masterful hand. His youth and creativity go hand in hand with a complete overhaul of the restaurant area.

So it's in this new atmosphere of fine curves that the chef offers his latest gourmet delights.

François Jagut, who is originally from Brittany, offers a contemporary cuisine that draws its inspiration from the seasons. He fell into cooking when he was a child, thanks in particular to his grandmother. In his own words, "Cooking is a passion that I've cultivated since I was a child".

After training at a hotel management school, it was his work placements in Michelin-starred establishments that enabled him to acquire solid experience. These included the Domaine de Locguénolé (Relais & Château), a mecca for gourmets in Brittany, and the Chaîne d'Or, a gourmet restaurant in Normandy.

His meeting with Olivier Roellinger and his work with Marc Veyrat, two of France's great Michelin-starred chefs, were a great inspiration to him.

On 1 March 2005, he took his first seat at the piano in the restaurant Les Roses. He never left! He was Alain Pierron's chef de partie and then his second for almost 15 years. Replacing him at the the kitchen at Les Roses was the next logical step.

François Jagut chose Loïck Martinez, a young chef with a passion for his work, to support him and become his second in command.

In the dining room, the team at Les Roses will be on hand to offer advice, a warm welcome and impeccable service.

The Maître d'Hôtel, Valérie Boyenval, is there to welcome you with her trademark smile. Her recent experience in prestigious establishments such as Fouquet's in Paris, the Negresco Palace in Nice and the Papagayo in St-Tropez gives her an unrivalled credentials.

Backed by his experience and love of his job, Head Sommelier Thierry Corona, voted Gault&Milau Luxembourg Head Sommelier of the Year 2023, will be able to present you with the wine that goes perfectly with the dishes served. 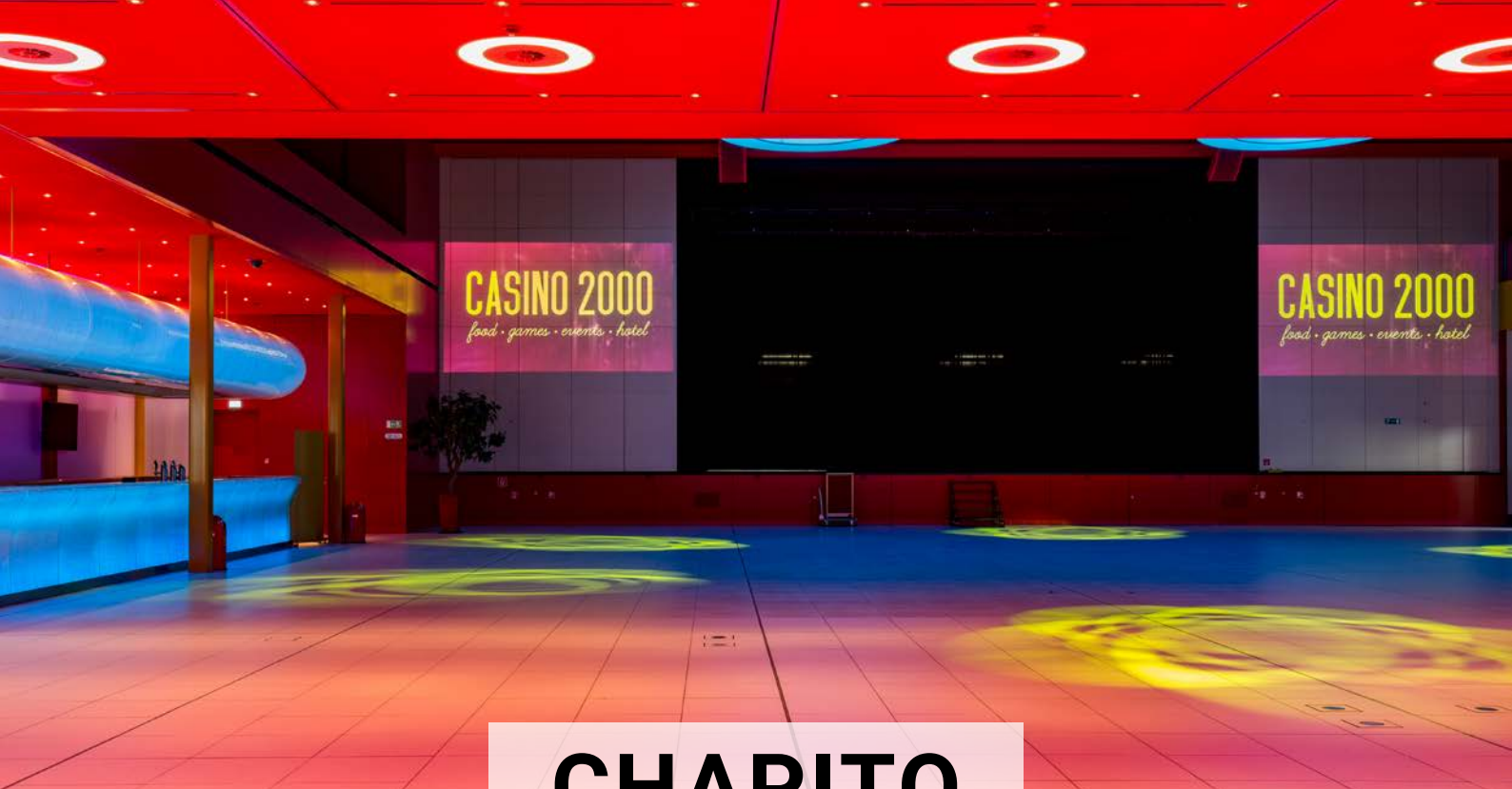

When the first stone of CHAPITO was laid on 18 March 2009, the objective was clear. 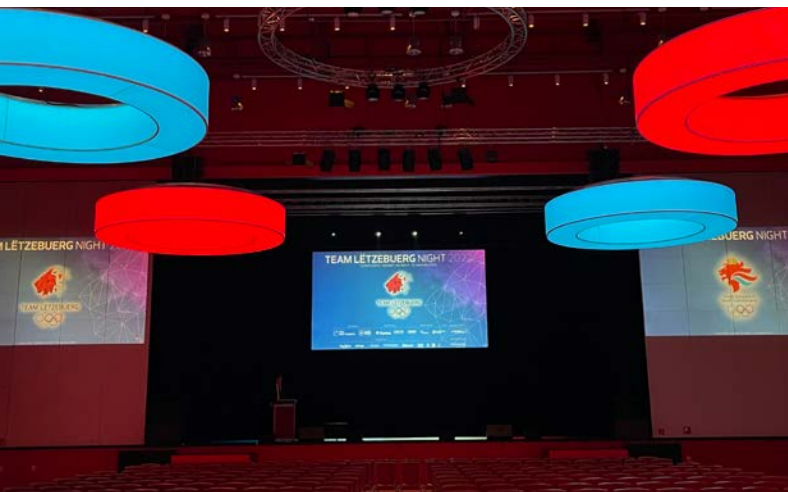
The Galerie is the ideal venue for more intimate trade shows, product presentations or art exhibitions.

It has also been awarded other labels, including ESR-Entrepise Responsable, which commits it to a process of sustainable development and the creation of shared value for its activities.

The Sécher & Gesond mat System label recognises effective management of health and safety at work through risk prevention.

HISTORICAL ORIGINS

THE BLANC BROTHERS

Around 1840, twins François and Louis Blanc left their native Bordeaux to settle in Luxembourg. The brothers, who had some experience in banking and gaming, set about obtaining a licence to operate a casino. They lived in the Hotel de Cologne at the time, which was also the residence of the governor of the federal fortress, Landgrave Louis de Homburg, who in Luxembourg was known simply as the "Prince of Homburg". His brother, the Sovereign Landgrave Philipp de Homburg, was visiting relatives in Luxembourg at the time and happened to meet the Blanc brothers.

The Blanc brothers had been refused permission by Luxembourg to build a casino, so they obtained permission from Landgrave Philipp de Homburg to build a gaming establishment in Bad Homburg vor der Höhe, a town at the foot of the Taunus mountains.

On 23 May 1841, the Blanc brothers turned the roulette wheel for the first time and laid the foundation stone of what was to become a sumptuous spa on the same day. In this way, they influenced the fate of the small, insignificant spa town, which was transformed in just a few decades into a fashionable spa resort with an international reputation.

The contract signed between Landgrave Philipp and the Blanc brothers granted them the privilege of "exercising games of chance" for 30 years. The conditions attached to this authorisation - namely the construction of a spa, which would become the property of the landgrave once completed, and the payment of an annual lease amounting to a maximum of 10,000 florins - ultimately proved to represent only a tiny proportion of the real contribution made by the casino's proprietors to promoting "the prosperity of the town".

François Blanc, who ran the casino alone from 1851 after the early death of his brother, was a shrewd manager. The attraction of gambling for people, the benefits of the thermal baths, the medicinal properties of the springs and the luxurious entertainment options were the arguments on which he based the massive publicity he carried out in favour of the Bad Homburg thermal spa and gaming centre among the major economic and social centres of Europe. The image of the small residential town of Bad Homburg vor der Höhe, unknown and poor only a short time before, had changed radically.

However, Bad Homburg's good fortune was not to last indefinitely. The Blancs' casino era in Bad Homburg came to a definitive end in 1866, when the town became part of the Prussian state, which ordered the casino closed in 1872.

However, François Blanc had correctly interpreted the political changes that were taking place, and in 1863 he had already become a casino owner in Monte Carlo, where he repeated the "miracle of Bad Homburg" and laid the foundation stone for the Monte Carlo casino, which was to acquire the same name.



HISTORICAL ORIGINS

CASINO 2000

The idea of creating a gambling establishment in Luxembourg was revived in 1923, when the deputy Eugène Steichen presented a bill to the Chamber of Deputies for the granting of a concession for a casino to be built in Mondorf. The municipality of Echternach was quick to act on this proposal, too, to obtain a concession to operate a casino. But at the time, neither of them received the desired gaming licence.

In 1946, Mondorf-les-Bains again requested authorisation to set up a casino in the spa area, and the Chamber of Deputies passed a bill to authorise gambling in Luxembourg. However, the proposal was again rejected by 29 votes to 17.

In 1977, 31 years later, the situation had changed! The Chamber of Deputies passed a bill under which “gaming establishments in which various games of chance may be played” were to be authorised in Luxembourg. This majority vote gave the go-ahead for the construction of a casino in Luxembourg. The law of 20 April 1977 is no less than 55 pages long and regulates automatic games, casinos, lotteries and gambling of all kinds, under the heading “Games of chance”.

After months of negotiations to determine the location, Mondorf-les-Bains was chosen on 30 September 1977 as the sole site for the whole of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg.

On 19 December 1980, the government granted the Mondorf-les-Bains casino a concession authorising the construction of a gaming establishment, 127 years after the first application was submitted for a casino in the spa town.

On 15 April 1981, the memorial received the names of all the shareholders of the “Casino de jeux du Luxembourg, Mondorf-les-Bains/ Luxemburgische Spielbank Bad Mondorf” founded on 19 February.

On 8 May 1982, the foundation stone for CASINO 2000 was laid. The owners had invested a total of LUF 350 million in Mondorf-les-Bains, created around 100 jobs and given new impetus to local and national tourism. Numerous guests of honour attended the ceremony, including the ministers at the time, Jacques Santer, Fernand Boden and René Konnen, Secretary of State Ernest Mühlen, other members of the government and many prominent figures from public life. Finance Minister Jacques Santer carried out the formal part of the foundation stone laying, murralling the official deed.

After 695 days of design, planning and construction, CASINO 2000 was handed over to its destiny on 16 April 1983 at a solemn inauguration.

Hundreds of guests accepted the invitation, including 4 ministers, a secretary of state and numerous representatives of political and social life, as well as the diplomatic corps. The CASINO 2000 village hall was packed to capacity with 350 guests.

In his opening speech, the Chairman of the Board of Directors, Werner Wilhelm Wicker, explained that CASINO 2000 should be a place dedicated to its guests and to social encounters. He said that people had been at the heart of the building's design. He stated that a 50,000 m² horse race track was to be built within the next 3 months, on which international equestrian tournaments would be held in the future.

Finally, the Mayor of Bad Homburg, Wolfgang R. Assmann, spoke of Bad Homburg's historic splendour and described Werner Wilhelm Wicker as the François Blanc of the modern era.

Finance Minister Jacques Santer gave the closing speech before cutting the golden ribbon and handing the golden ball to the roulette tables, officially opening the games. The roulette and blackjack tables, as well as the automatic games, were literally taken over by the participants.
